With help from his uncle, he trained his first horse at the age of ten. He continued to train horses and at the age of 16 he went to work for Bill Hudson for six weeks out of the year. Mr. Hudson had over 120 head that he trained each year. Jeff worked with Mr. Hudson once, sometimes twice a year, until he was 23 and trained an uncountable number of Bill Hudson's quarter horses.

Jeff started riding saddle broncos when he was 15 and continued riding until he was thirty years old. His love for the rodeo brought him to the states where he met and fell in love with his wife. He now makes his home in Eugene, MO.
